Music LIVE As They Play on Their Tour Of Ireland

<p>Day 1 February 26 Friday</p>	<p>USA to Ireland. Depart USA for overnight flight to Ireland. Dinner is served aloft.</p>
<p>Day 2 February 27 Saturday</p>	<p>Dublin. Morning arrival at Dublin Airport where you are greeted by your Driver/Guide. Leaving the airport we travel to a nearby venue where everyone will have an opportunity for their first Full Irish Breakfast (on own expense). We travel into Dublin Town where we enjoy a panoramic tour of this 1000-year old city. We then see statue filled <i>O'Connell Street, The General Post Office scene of the 1916 Easter Uprising, as well as Georgian Square.</i> Our group will then enjoy an optional visit to the Guinness Brewery. Group will be dropped off on Nassau Street for some free browsing time. We will then check into our hotel LATE AFTERNOON. Dinner is on your own, suggestions will be provided. Overnight Dublin at The Camden Court or similar.</p>
<p>Day 3 February 28 Sunday</p>	<p>Dublin-Glendalough-Dublin. After breakfast we depart Dublin and travel south. Enjoy today in Dublin city or join us on an optional tour of Glendalough. Our first stop is Enniskerry, a scenic village located in a valley and surrounded by rich vegetation. We continue on through the Wicklow Mountains to visit <i>Glendalough.</i> Here we see the round tower and ruined churches of the 6th century monastery and stop at the visitor center for an explanation of the history of the settlement. We return to Dublin for overnight. Dinner is on your own. <i>Entertainment this evening.</i> Overnight Dublin at The Camden Court or similar.</p>
<p>Day 4 March 1 Monday</p>	<p>Dublin-Blarney-Killarney. We enjoy a fabulous full Irish breakfast this morning. It is on through Naas, home of the Irish National Stud Farm where many of the world's famous thoroughbred horses are raised. We continue south to <i>Blarney</i> with its famous 14th century kissing stone and plentiful woolen mills. We continue over The Kerry and Cork Mountains to Killarney. Plenty of time this afternoon to explore this quaint town with its plentiful shops and pubs. Overnight Killarney at The International Hotel or similar. Dinner is on your own.</p>
<p>Day 5 March 2 Tuesday</p>	<p>Ring of Kerry. After breakfast we then travel today on <i>The Ring of Kerry.</i> <i>You may also decide to stay put or enjoy Killarney Town on your own. Optional Horse-Back Riding at Killarney Stables or Golf Day at Killarney Golf Club..</i> There is an unspoiled nature to Ireland's most beautiful region and the <i>Ring of Kerry</i> provides many unforgettable memories as it passes through the many picturesque villages such as Glenbeigh, Waterville and Sneem and returns via Ladies View and the famous Lakes of Killarney. Optional Jaunting Cart Ride through Killarney National Park. You might also decide to visit The Muckcross House and Estate. Muckcross House is a magnificent Victorian mansion and one of Ireland's leading stately homes. The elegantly furnished rooms portray the lifestyle of the landed gentry, while downstairs in the basement one can experience the working conditions of the servants employed in the Estate. The gardens benefit from the natural setting of the mountains and lakes of Killarney. Rolling grasslands lead on to an expanse of mature rhododendrons, punctuated by boles of Scots pine. Overnight Killarney. Dinner is at our hotel this evening. Overnight Killarney at The International Hotel. <i>Entertainment this evening.</i></p>
<p>Day 6 March 3 Wednesday</p>	<p>Killarney-Adare-Limerick-Cliffs of Moher-Galway. After a full Irish Breakfast we depart Killarney and travel north first stopping at Adare, once voted "The Prettiest Village" with its thatched roof cottages. We continue through Limerick, Ireland's 3rd largest city and home to author Frank McCourt who wrote Angela's Ashes. It is then onto the Majestic Cliffs of Moher. The Cliffs rise 700 feet and stretch out along the Atlantic coastline for Five Miles. We continue through the rugged Burren landscape, a limestone region dotted with caves and rivers and many ancient megalithic tombs. Our group arrives into Galway city. We take some time here to enjoy this youthful bustling town with a walk from Eyre Square down traditional "Shop Street". Overnight Galway. Dinner is on your own. Overnight The Imperial Hotel or similar.</p>
<p>Day 7 March 4 Thursday</p>	<p>Aran Islands. After a full Irish Breakfast we enjoy an optional tour of The Aran Islands. Inis Mór is the largest of the three Aran Islands and is the most developed in terms of tourist facilities. There are about 900 inhabitants on Inis Mór making it by far the most populated of the islands. The main village on the island is Kilonan, which has a quite large harbour that accommodates a vast amount of tourist travel to the island. There are minibuses as well as horse and carts to take people around. Those not taking the tour have a free day to explore Galway city We return to Galway where we have plenty of time for browsing or shopping before enjoying a Farewell Dinner and overnight at our hotel. <i>Entertainment this evening.</i></p>

Day 8 March 5 Friday	Galway-Shannon-USA. After breakfast we transfer to Shannon Airport for our flight home. Arrive home the same day. In the true Irish Tradition we wish you a "Safe Home".
