<p>Day 1 February 19 Saturday</p>	<p>NYC-Paris. Overnight flight from New York to Paris. Dinner served shortly after take off.</p>
<p>Day 2 February 15 Sunday</p>	<p>Paris. Upon arrival in Paris we are privately transferred to our city center Hotel, Park Lane. The hotel is located within walking distance from the most prestigious places of Paris such as the Champs Elysées, the luxurious street of Faubourg Saint Honoré and the 2 biggest department stores of Paris Printemps and Galleries Lafayette. There is good public transport close to the hotel. After a swift check-in we enjoy some free time to discover “ <i>The City of Light</i>” Overnight Paris Park Lane</p>
<p>Day 3 February 16 Monday</p>	<p>Paris City Tour & Museum Walking Tour. After breakfast we meet our tour @ 9:45AM. This panoramic tour will take you around all the main monuments of Paris. First discover the Louvre Museum, then pass by the Island of the City and see the famous Cathedral of Notre Dame. We continue to the prestigious Sorbonne University and the Pantheon. St. Germain des Pres and the Orsay Museum will also be part of the itinerary. Of course this tour would not be complete without a ride down the Champs Elysees and up to the Arc de Triumph. The Eiffel Tower will be the next famous sight and the last part of this small journey will include the Invalids, Place de la Concorde, the Madeleine and the Opera. After lunch (on own) we enjoy a Guided Walking Tour of The Louvre. The tour will start at 2:15PM. There is no queuing at the Louvre with this tour. The tour will begin under the Great Pyramid and then continue inside the Louvre, where a guide presents various areas such as the modern pyramid, the Egyptian department and the museum's most famous works such as the Mona Lisa by Leonardo da Vinci. <p>Day 4 February 17 Tuesday</p>	<p>Reims Champagne Optional Tour. We will depart on this tour @ 8:00AM and be gone till the evening. The sacred town of Reims is the capital of the Champagne region and known throughout the world for its sparkling wine, Champagne. Reims is also the city of coronations where most of the French kings were crowned. Our morning orientation tour of Reims includes a guided visit to the gothic cathedral. We then visit the Mumm Cellars, with a tasting of the famous Cordon Rouge Champagne wine. There is free time for lunch (at your own expense) in the afternoon and you will be able to enjoy the picturesque landscape of vines between Reims and Epernay. At Epernay we will visit the prestigious wine cellars of Moet & Chandon Champagne Cellars. Overnight Paris Park Lane</p>
<p>Day 5 February 18 Wednesday</p>	<p>Paris. Day on own. I suggest a self-walking tour from your hotel via Chatlet and into the Latin Quarter. This bustling student center has great vibrant sidewalk cafes with function all year. You can also try the Metro system. Totally clean and easy to maneuver. Overnight Paris Park Lane</p>
<p>Day 6 February 19 Thursday</p>	<p>Normandy Optional Tour. After breakfast we meet our tour for departure @ 8:00AM. You will be gone all day. Reaching the heart of Normandy, you will begin your day with a visit to the Caen Peace Memorial. After this visit you will visit the landing sites of Point du Hoc, Arromanches, The Batterie de Longues, Omaha Beach and the American Cemetery. Overnight Paris Park Lane</p>
<p>Day 7 February 20 Friday</p>	<p>Paris-USA. Morning departure for Paris Charles De Gaulle Airport where you will have plenty of time for last minute duty-free shopping before boarding our flight home. Arrive home the same day.</p>
