DAY 1	May 12 Saturday	USA to Scotland. Depart USA for overnight flight to Scotland. Dinner is served while in flight.
DAY 2	May 13 Sunday	Glasgow. Morning arrival at Glasgow Airport where, after clearing Customs, we meet our Professional Scottish Driver Guide and Hammond Tours Staff. Leaving the airport, we drive to Stirling to visit the former home of Mary Queen of Scots, Stirling Castle - a great symbol of Scottish independence and enduring national pride. Its long, turbulent history is associated with great figures from Scotland's past such as William Wallace and Robert the Bruce. Time permitting, we'll drive by the National Wallace Monument , where you may have the opportunity to take in the magnificent tribute to Scotland's national hero - William Wallace (optional cost). From there, it's back to Glasgow , Scotland's largest city, for a panoramic tour. After checking into the hotel, you're at your leisure to explore this cosmopolitan city. Visit the Glasgow Cathedral or the Gallery of Modern Art . Take in the tall ship, the <i>Glenlee</i> , on your way to the Riverside Museum . Or see the beautiful Glasgow Botanic Gardens . Dinner is on your own. Overnight at Jury's Inn.
DAY 3	May 14 Monday	Ayrshire. After breakfast, we drive to the west-coastal village of Alloway to pay homage to Scotland's world-renowned national bard. We'll visit the new, magnificent Robert Burns Birthplace Museum , which comprises the Burns Cottage where the poet was born, the landmarks where he set his greatest works, the monument and gardens created in his honor, and a museum housing the world's most important collection of his life and works. Then we return to Glasgow. Dinner with the group at Jury's Inn. Performance tonight at Laurie's Acoustic Music Bar. Overnight at Jury's Inn.
DAY 4	May 15 Tuesday	Atholl Palace! After breakfast, we'll tour through North Lanarkshire and West Lothian before a stop in Falkirk to visit the Falkirk Wheel . The Wheel is a feat of modern engineering that joins the Forth and Clyde Canal with the Union Canal, and replaces the previous nearly-3-hour passage of 11 locks with a 5-1/2 minute transition. Eventually we come to Pitlochry and the majestic 19 th -century baronial estate of Atholl Palace , designed by the renowned Scottish architect Andrew Helton. The rest of the day is yours to revel in the amenities this estate has to offer: enjoy a woodlands walk, take a Highland safari, go salmon fishing, play a match on the Highland Tennis Championship Courts or nine holes of Pitch 'n' Putt golf. Rejuvenate yourself in the state of the art Lavender Spa, or stroll through the spectacular Japanese or formal gardens. Sleep like a king or queen tonight in your luxurious bedroom. Dinner and overnight at Atholl Palace.
DAY 5	May 16 Wednesday	Pitlochry - Inverness. After breakfast, we depart Pitlochry and wind our way to Fort William. We'll visit the series of eight locks that comprise Neptune's Staircase at the foot of the Caledonian Canal. From there, we'll head northeast along the west bank of Loch Ness . We'll stop for a visit of the ruins of Urquhart Castle , one of the largest strongholds of medieval Scotland. We finish the day's travels in Inverness, the capital city of the Highlands that dates back to a 6th-century settlement. Dinner is on your own. Performance tonight at Hootananny's. Overnight at the Thistle Hotel.
DAY 6	May 17 Thursday	Inverness. Traveling from Inverness, our first stop will be Culloden , the site of the bloody battle that ended the 1745 Jacobite Rebellion. Onwards then to follow the Spey Valley Whisky trail to the Glenfiddich Distillery . We'll hear how the famous drink is made before sampling a 'wee dram' ourselves. Then it's on to a tour of the Speyside Cooperage . We may even squeeze in a stop in Elgin to visit the magnificent ruins of Elgin Cathedral . Then we return to Inverness. Dinner is on your own. Concert tonight at the Nairn Community & Arts Centre. Overnight at the Thistle Hotel.
DAY 7	May 18 Friday	Inverness - Edinburgh. After breakfast, we make our final departure from the city of Inverness, heading south through the Cairngorm Mountains. We emerge from the Cairngorms National Park , returning to Pitlochry to view the Edinburgh Woollen Mill and the Salmon Ladder . We push on through Perth, then on to Dunfermline where we visit the incredible Dunfermline Abbey , home to over 1000 years of Scotland's richest history as well as the final resting place of King Robert the Bruce. Dinner is on your own. Overnight at the Mercure Point Hotel.
DAY 8	May 19 Saturday	Edinburgh. Today is a free day in Edinburgh. We suggest a Hop-On/Hop-Off Edinburgh Tour Bus-Pass. See Edinburgh Castle , the majestic landmark that dominates Edinburgh's skyline, perched on an extinct volcano; the Palace of Holyroodhouse , the Queen's official residence in Scotland; or the Royal Mile , the famous cobbled street that links the Palace and the Castle and is full of historic buildings and places of interest. Other noteworthy landmarks include the National Monument , Scotland's memorial to those who died fighting for the United Kingdom in the Napoleonic Wars; the Scott Monument honoring Sir Walter Scott, one of Scotland's greatest writers; the Burns Monument , a tribute to Scotland's National Bard; the National Gallery ; the Royal Scottish Academy ; the Camera Obscura ; or Greyfriar's Bobby . At some point, be sure to drop by and visit to Edinburgh's oldest public house this afternoon, the Sheep Heid Inn , established in 1360. Dinner is on your own. Overnight at the Mercure Point Hotel.
DAY 9	May 20 Sunday	Edinburgh to USA. After breakfast, we transfer to Edinburgh Airport for our flight home. Arrive home the same day. In the true Scottish Tradition we wish you a "Fair faw, an' haste ye back!".
