Day 1 Friday October 15	USA to Scotland. Depart USA for overnight flight to Scotland. Dinner is served aloft.
Day 2 Saturday October 16	Edinburgh. Arrive into Edinburgh airport where you will meet your tour guide and board our coach bound for the centre of this beautiful city. En route to our hotel take in a panoramic city tour where you will see Murrayfield Stadium, Royal Lyceum Theatre, the Royal Mile, and the Scottish Parliament before we arrive at Edinburgh Castle for a tour. The rest of the day is at your leisure. Overnight in Edinburgh at The Holiday Inn Hotel. Dinner is on your own suggestions will be provided
Day 3 Sunday October 17	Edinburgh. We start our day with a visit to the Royal Yacht Britannia - a magnificent ship which has played host to some of the most famous people in the world, but most importantly, it was home to Her Majesty the Queen and the Royal Family. After our tour why not visit the Scotch Whisky Heritage Centre for a tour and a tasting of Scotland's national drink. Overnight in Edinburgh Overnight in Edinburgh at The Holiday Inn Hotel. Dinner is on your own. <i>Optional, Enjoy a Scottish banquet with unlimited wine during the meal, followed by laughter, songs, dancing & music, performed by some of Scotland's most accomplished artists. The meal consists of traditional Scottish fare, including a choice of 2 options for each course including such favorites as Scotch broth, Salmon, Beef or Chicken for main course.</i>
Day 4 Monday October 18	Edinburgh-Dunblane-Inverness. We leave Edinburgh behind today and travel north to Inverness. Dunblane lies on the hills above the Forth valley and Stirling on the southern edge of Perthshire. The Allan Water flows through the town We visit Dunblane Cathedral. The lower part of the cathedral tower is the oldest surviving part dating from the 12th century. The main cathedral was built by Bishop Clement in the middle of the 13th century. Inside the Cathedral you will see some of Scotland's finest Medieval carved woodwork Upon arrival into Inverness we will visit the ruins of Urquhart Castle , located on the shores of Loch Ness. Overnight in Inverness at the Thistle Hotel Inverness. Dinner is on your own.
Day 5 Tuesday October 19	Inverness-Skye. From Inverness we will make our way along the banks of Loch Ness. We will have a stop for photographs by the loch side— keep a careful look out, just in case you know who makes an appearance! From Invermoriston we head westwards through Glen Moriston to Glen Shiel, where we will see the ' Five Sisters ' - a range of five mountains that dominate the surrounding landscape. We'll make a photo-stop at Eilean Donan Castle , perched on its island at the head of Loch Duich. Soon we will cross ' over the sea to Skye ' by way of the road bridge and head for Sleat, the garden of Skye. Dinner and overnight King Arms, Kyleakin.
Day 6 Wednesday October 20	Skye-Ft. William. We depart Skye and travel via Mallaig & Glenfinnan to Fort William. Fort William is the second largest town in Highlands, and is situated close to Glen Coe, Ben Nevis and Glenfinnan. Fort William takes its name from William of Orange. The actual fort was built during Oliver Cromwell's time to control the local people. After several name changes it was renamed again, this time after Prince William, the Duke of Cumberland, also known to the Scots people as Butcher Cumberland. Dinner and Overnight Ben Nevis Hotel Ft William.
Day 7 Thursday October 21	Ft William-Stirling-Glasgow. After breakfast we depart Ft William and travel via Glencoe to Stirling. Upon arrival into Stirling we will visit the former home of Mary Queen of Scots, Stirling Castle. Stirling Castle is a great symbol of Scottish independence and a source of enduring national pride. The castle's long, turbulent history is associated with great figures from Scotland's past such as William Wallace and Robert the Bruce. We then board our coach and continue our journey to Glasgow for our overnight stay. Overnight in Glasgow at Jurys Inn. Dinner is on your own
Day 8 Friday October 22	Glasgow-USA. Morning departure for Glasgow Airport and our flight home. Arrive home the same day!
