<p>Day 1 Saturday October 13</p>	<p>USA to Scotland. Depart USA for overnight flight to Scotland. Dinner is served aloft.</p>
<p>Day 2 Sunday October 14</p>	<p>Glasgow-Edinburgh. Morning arrival at Glasgow Airport where, after clearing Customs, we meet our Professional Scottish Driver Guide and Hammond Tours Staff. Leaving the airport, we drive to Stirling to visit the former home of Mary Queen of Scots, Stirling Castle - a great symbol of Scottish independence and enduring national pride. <p>Day 3 Monday October 15</p>	<p>Edinburgh. Morning sightseeing in Edinburgh including visits to Edinburgh Castle and the Scottish Whisky Experience. Afternoon to Dunfermline to view the Abbey & Pittencrieff Park (Andrew Carnegie). Overnight in Edinburgh Overnight in Edinburgh at The Holiday Inn Hotel or similar. Dinner is on your own. Optional, Enjoy a Scottish banquet with unlimited wine during the meal, followed by laughter, songs, dancing & music, performed by some of Scotland's most accomplished artists. Continue afterwards via Pitlochry to Killiecrankie, scene of a famous battle, and a stop at Killiecrankie Visitor Centre. Our third visit this day will be to a Scotch Whisky Distillery. Continue to Inverness for a stop, then via Urquhart Castle (view only) on to the Isle of Skye. Dinner and overnight Dunollie Hotel.</p>
<p>Day 5 Wednesday October 17</p>	<p>Skye. Full day Skye Excursion. We visit Dunvegan Castle ad the island's main town of Portree and pass the spectacular Cuillin Hills. of Skye. Dinner and overnight Dunollie Hotel.</p>
<p>Day 6 Thursday October 18</p>	<p>Skye-Oban. Travel to Armadale and take the half-hour ferry crossing to Mallaig. We then travel through more beautiful scenery with a short stop at the Glenfinnan Monument erected in 1815 to mark the place where "Bonnie Prince Charlie" raised his standard, at the beginning of the 1745 Jacobite Rising. Also stop in the town of Fort William, overlooked by Britain's highest mountain, Ben Nevis. Continuing south we travel through the spectacular Pass of Glencoe with a short stop at Glencoe Visitor Centre, then continue to Oban. Dinner and overnight Regent Hotel Oban.</p>
<p>Day 7 Friday October 19</p>	<p>Isle of Mull. Full Scottish breakfast at the hotel. Take the 40 minute crossing to the beautiful Isle of Mull. Continue across the island and take the little foot passenger ferry to the legendary Isle of Iona, before returning to the mainland. Dinner and overnight Regent Hotel Oban</p>
<p>Day 8 Saturday October 20</p>	<p>Oban-Glasgow-USA. Morning departure for Glasgow Airport and our flight home. Arrive home the same day!</p>
