## Itinerary

Day 1 October 11 Friday	Edinburgh. Arrive Edinburgh Airport where you will be one group transfer to your Edinburgh hotel. Edinburgh is one of Europe's most beautiful cities, draped across a series of rocky hills overlooking the sea. It's a town intimately entwined with its landscape, with buildings and monuments perched atop crags and overshadowed by cliffs. Edinburgh is a city that begs to be discovered, filled with quirky, come-hither nooks that tempt you to explore just that little bit further. Spend some free time exploring this city on your own. <b>Overnight at The Courtyard by Marriott Edinburgh.</b> Edinburgh-Glasgow. After breakfast at our hotel we begin our journey with a tour of Edinburgh City. Then it is onto Edinburgh
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Day 2 October 12 Saturday	Castle. The Castle is thought to be one of the most haunted places in Scotland and there of paranormal activity throughout the castle grounds by visitors and staff alike. Form. There will be time for lunch at the Castle on your own. After lunch we will make our way to Rosslyn Chapel, this beautiful church which was the backdrop for the novel "The Da Vinci Code". Still time this afternoon for us to visit the famous and renowned Stirling Castle and one of Scotland's finest stately homes, Hopetoun House – still in use today. The we head to Glasgow. <b>Overnight at The Hallmark Hotel Glasgow.</b>
Day 3 October 13 Sunday	Glasgow-Ft. William. We will start our day with a visit to the ghost of The Highlands at Inveraray Castle, seat of Clan Campbell and to the Inveraray Jail. Will you spot the specter of the young Irish harpist who was killed by the Duke of Montrose's men in 1644 and reportedly haunts the MacArthur Room of the Castle? Time for lunch today at the tea room at Inveraray Castle. After lunch we will take the beautiful drive through Trossachs to Glencoe. With a stop at the Glencoe visitor's center. Then on to our destination Ft. William. <b>Overnight at Ben Nevis Hotel Ft. William.</b>
Day 4 October 14 Monday	Ft. William-Inverness. Our first stop today is at the Glenfinnan Monument. This tall column topped by a kilted Highlander was erected on the spot Bonnie Prince Charles rallied the Jacobite rebels in an attempt to restore Stewarts to the throne. Here, where the standard was raised we have views of the Viaduct, known as Harry Potter's Hogwarts Bridge. And then it is Inveraray Castle, seat of Clan Campbell and to the Inveraray Jail, photogenically seated at the entrance to Loch Duich. This one of Scotland's most evocative castles. This castle is said to be haunted by a Spanish soldier who was killed in the 1 <sup>st</sup> Jacobite rebellion. This afternoon we will have

some free time in Inverness. In the evening we will be doing a ghost walk at Clava Cairns, the prehistoric bronze age cairoutlanns dating back 4000 years. The evocative cemetery site retains original features, including passage graves, standing stones, and ring cairns

(stone circles). As with many prehistoric burial sites, the Clava Cairns remain somewhat of a mystery. Historians can only theorize about their purpose or meaning. The cairns' alignment suggest midwinter sunset was an important time for those who built it, but it's not known exactly why it was so significant. **Overnight at Columba Hotel Inverness.** 

- Day 5Inverness. Today we unravel the mystery surrounding Loch Ness with a 1-hour cruise on the waters from Clansman harbor. ThoughOctober 15stories of a mysterious lake monster date back to the 7th century, they didn't become mainstream until 1933 when a London man<br/>claimed to have seen a prehistoric beast on the Loch Ness shores. Locals came out of the woodwork with additional claims of their<br/>own. Along the way on our cruise we make our way to Urquhart Castle for a self-guided tour of the thrilling romantic ruins. We will<br/>then head to a visit of the Culloden battlefield and museum which will ready us for the evening. After sunset we will do a ghost walk of<br/>Culloden Battlefield, where thousands of Highlanders and their allies lost their lives in the '45 Jacobite rising. In fact, it was here the<br/>defeat of Bonnie Prince Charlie and the end of the Jacobite dream when 1200 highlanders were slaughtered in 68 minutes. Overnight<br/>at Columba Hotel Inverness.
- Day 6Inverness- Aberdeen. We start our day with a drive through the stunning Cairngorms, this wild mountain landscape of granite and<br/>heather has a sub-Arctic climate and supports rare alpine tundra vegetation and high-altitude bird species, such as snow bunting,<br/>ptarmigan and dotterel. This area has 6 of the highest summits in the UK. Then we make our way to Crathes castle, The castle was first<br/>built in the 1500s by the Burnett family with the brooding tower house still standing. It is said to be haunted by the restless spirit of<br/>the Green Lady, a ghostly apparition dressed in a green robe. It is said that she was a servant girl or a ward of the Laird who<br/>disappeared soon after having a child. In the 1800s, skeletal remains were found behind the fireplace in a room she has been spotted<br/>in. Next stop is Dunnottar Castle, This dramatic and evocative ruined cliff top fortress was the home of the Earls Marischal, once one<br/>of the most powerful families in Scotland. Steeped in history, this romantic and haunting ruin is a photographer's paradise, a history<br/>lover's dream and an iconic tourist destination for visitors the world over. Also, time for a stop at Gordon highlanders Museum.<br/>Overnight at Copthorne Hotel Aberdeen.

# Day 7Aberdeen- Edinburgh. We start our day with a ½ day tour of St. Andrews. Stopping at St. Andrews Cathedral and Castle. TheOctober 17Cathedral is rumored to be haunted by two ghosts, a friendly monk who has been encountered on the stairs at St Rule's Tower, and<br/>the beautiful White Lady. For the past 200 years people have reported sightings of a lady wearing white gloves, gliding through the<br/>grounds before vanishing at the cathedral's haunted tower. This afternoon we will visit Doune Castle, feathered in the TV series,<br/>Outlander and Game of Thrones. Magnificent Doune Castle is one of the best-preserved medieval fortresses in Scotland, having<br/>remained largely unchanged since it was built for the duke of Albany in the 14th century.. We also will stop at Linlithgow, birthplace<br/>of Mary Queen of Scots. This spooky site was once a silent witness to the glittering majesty of Scottish kings, Linithgow Palace was one<br/>of the jewels in Scotland's crown. But after everyone has gone home, what ghosts walk these dark corridors at night? Overnight at<br/>Courtyard by Marriott Edinburgh.

Day 8Edinburgh Airport. After breakfast there will be 1 group transfer to Edinburgh Airport for our fight home.October 18Friday
