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Day 1 — Coastlines & Poetry: *Glasgow to Ayrshire*



Arrive in Glasgow and meet your professional Scottish driver-guide. At 10:00 AM, we head west along the awe-inspiring Scottish coastline.

First stop: the dramatic cliff-top masterpiece of **Culzean Castle** — grand, elegant, and quintessentially, Scottish.

Then a short trape to **Robbie Burns**' birthplace museum and cottage. The “Bard of Scotland” opulent verses come alive when you stand where he stood; *Old Lang Syne et al.*

By afternoon, we arrive the coastal “Toon of Irvine” — Graham's hometown — for a personal introduction to his roots.

Day 2 — Isle of Arran: Scotland in Miniature: *Hebridean Island Adventure*



After breakfast, we ferry from Ardrossan to the Isle of Arran — mountains, sea cliffs, castles, and ancient mysteries packed into one stunning island.

Highlights include: The romantic shoreline ruins of **Kildonan Castle**; a guided whisky-tasting at **Lagg Distiller**; a walk-about the prehistoric standing stones of Machrie Moor. Return to the mainland late afternoon, sea air in your lungs and a dram or two in your spirit.

Day 3 — Stirling & Scotland's Capital: *Highlands to Edinburgh*



This morning after breakfast, we travel north-central into the Highlands – and the **Royal Burgh of Stirling**. Majestically seated at the highest point, is the incomparable, Stirling Castle — the strategic heart of medieval Scotland.

There we will tour Mary Queen of Scots' magnificent Castle; one of Scotland's grandest royal fortresses.

Then onward to Scotland's capital, Edinburgh. Elegant, historic, and endlessly walkable. The afternoon is yours to wander the Royal Mile, browse shops, and a jar oor' twa at Deacon Brodie's.

Overnight: at the old-town elegant YOTEL in Edinburgh's center (3 nights)

Day 4 — Abbeys of the Borders: *History & Legends*



After a hearty Scottish breakfast, we journey into the mountainous/ rolling "Borders" countryside and visit the hauntingly beautiful ruins of: **Jedburgh Abbey** and **Melrose Abbey**.

These sacred sites are deeply tied to **Robert the Bruce** and Scotland's turbulent past. Back in Edinburgh, enjoy free time — or, for the ambitious, hike up "Arthur's Seat" with Zig before rewarding yourself with a pint oor' twa at the Tollhouse Pub.

Overnight: YOTEL Edinburgh

Day 5 — Royal Scotland: *Kings, Crowns & Castles*





After breakfast, we journey into historic Fife at **Dunfermline Palace and Abbey**, resting place of Scottish kings, and birthplace of Andrew Carnegie.
Return to Edinburgh to explore commanding **Edinburgh Castle**, home of the Scottish Crown Jewels and the beating heart of the nation's story. The afternoon is yours — shop, sightsee, and savour our last group-pint(ss)!
Overnight: YOTEL Edinburgh

Day 6 — Slàinte Mhath: *Departure – we're noo' d'awa' ta bide-awa!*

Transfer to Edinburgh Airport with stories worth retelling and memories that will last far longer than your luggage allowance.
