

	famous song 'The Vale of Avoca'. A short hop brings us to Avoca village, or 'Ballykissangel' as it's known in the BBC TV series, where				
	we can stop in for a pint in Fitzgeralds Pub. Then on through the rolling countryside arriving at beautiful Faithlegg House Hotel for a				
	special dinner together followed by a sing song / seisiún. Dinner & Overnight Faithlegg Hotel				
Day 4	Waterford. After breakfast you'll have a little time to explore the beautiful grounds of Faithlegg House, play a round of golf or enjoy the				
April 18	wonderful spa and leisure facilities. Refreshed, you'll meet local historian Andrew Doherty who will lead you through the stunning				
Tuesday	surrounding countryside, sharing tales and songs as we go. We will make our way to Jack Meades Bar (Irelands only fly over pub!) for				
	lunch and be joined by more local friends sure to entertain! After lunch we will visit Waterford - the Crystal City, and Ireland's oldest city,				
	founded by the Vikings in the 9th century. Visit the Waterford Crystal Center. Overnight Faithlegg Hotel				
Day 5	Waterford- After breakfast we meet our driver guide in the lobby of our hotel and head for New Ross, Co. Wexford and the Kennedy				
April 19	Homestead, The Donbrody Famine Ship and visitor center, learning about Ireland's long history of emigration, and perhaps even tracing				
Wednesday	your own family heritage and genealogy. After Lunch we will make our way through the beautiful countryside and villages of Co.				
	Wexford and Waterford to the charming fishing village of Dunmore East with its thatched cottages, cliffs and harbor. Enjoy dinner at one				
	of the many award-winning restaurants, followed by a night of local music. <b>Overnight Faithlegg Hotel</b>				
Day 6	Waterford- Kilkenny- After breakfast we meet our driver guide in the lobby of our hotel and head towards the medieval city of Kilkenny.				
April 20	On route we will visit the village of Thomastown, known for its ceramic studios, and Jerpoint Abbey founded in the 12 <sup>th</sup> century. We will				
Thursday	visit Grennan Mill Craft School and Studios, seeing the ancient arts and crafts of Ireland being passed on to the next generation of				
	contemporary makers. Then it's on to Kilkenny. After checking in at your hotel you will be free to explore for the afternoon or meet at the				
	famous Kittler's Inn for special Irish Dinner and Show (Optional). Afterwards, for the night owls among us, we'll find a bar in full swing				
	or a quiet corner to have our own wee seisiún together! Overnight River Court				

Day 7	Kilkenny- After breakfast we will make the short stroll to visit Kilkenny Castle, founded by the Normans in 1195. Later, we will explore

Friday	the Black Abbey Dominican priory, both from the 13th century. Kilkenny is also an arts and crafts hub, and we will spend some time				
	visiting Kilkenny Design Center with its makers' studios, café, gallery and store. We'll also stroll through Kilkenny's winding lanes filled				
	with shops selling pottery, paintings, and jewelry, and enjoy the sound of buskers contributing to the atmosphere of this bustling town.				
	Choose from many of the exceptional restaurants Kilkenny has to offer for dinner, before reconvening for live music and song into the				
	night. Overnight River Court				
Day 8	Kilkenny-Dublin. After breakfast we meet our driver guide in the lobby of our hotel and make the short trip to The Rock of Cashel, one of				
April 22	Ireland's most visited attractions and is a spectacular archaeological site dating back to the 12 <sup>th</sup> century. A collection of medieval				
Saturday	ecclesiastical buildings set on an outcrop of limestone in the Golden Vale, and a museum which houses the original Cross of St. Patrick.				
	After lunch we'll make our way to Dublin where after dinner we'll have one last farewell <i>seisiún</i> . <b>Overnight The Green Hotel</b>				
Day 9	Dublin Airport- After one more hearty Irish breakfast we make our way to Dublin Airport for our flight home, going our separate ways
