<b>DAY 1</b>	<b>April 10 Saturday</b>	<b>Arrive Edinburgh.</b> Welcome to Edinburgh — one of Europe's most dramatic and captivating cities! After arriving and checking in to your hotel on the iconic Royal Mile, the rest of the day is entirely your own. Stroll the cobbled lanes of the Old Town, climb Calton Hill for sweeping views across the city, lose yourself in the stunning National Museum of Scotland, or simply settle into a cosy pub and raise a glass to the adventure ahead. Edinburgh rewards the curious at every turn. Overnight: Ibis Edinburgh Centre Royal Mile.
<b>DAY 2</b>	<b>April 11 Sunday</b>	<b>Edinburgh – Rosslyn Chapel – Melrose Abbey – Peebles.</b> A leisurely start before our coach and guide collect us mid-morning. Our first stop is the breathtaking Rosslyn Chapel, made world-famous by The Da Vinci Code — we spend about an hour exploring this extraordinary 15th-century chapel is among Scotland's most intricately carved and mysterious buildings, drawing visitors from across the globe. After lunch at a spot your guide selects, we head into the heart of the Scottish Borders to the haunting ruins of Melrose Abbey, founded by King David I in 1136 and reputedly the burial place of Robert the Bruce's heart. We then make our way to the charming Victorian spa town of Peebles in the beautiful Tweed Valley. Dinner & Overnight: Peebles Hydro Hotel.
<b>DAY 3</b>	<b>April 12 Monday</b>	<b>Lochcarron Mill – Abbotsford House – Gala Dinner with Piper.</b> This morning we visit Lochcarron of Scotland, one of the world's leading weavers of fine tartan and tweed. Watch the looms in action and browse the mill shop for the perfect Scottish keepsake — a beautiful range of scarves, throws, and accessories made right here in the Borders. Larger groups may split coaches and visit in sequence. In the afternoon, we explore Abbotsford House & Gardens, the magnificent estate of Sir Walter Scott, widely regarded as the father of the historical novel. The house is beautifully preserved and filled with Scott's extraordinary personal collections; the estate café is a wonderful spot for lunch. This evening brings one of the tour's most special moments: a private Gala Dinner in the historic dining rooms of the Peebles Hydro Hotel, complete with a traditional Scottish Piper and the ceremonial Addressing of the Haggis — a true Burns Night experience. Dinner & Overnight: Peebles Hydro Hotel.
<b>DAY 4</b>	<b>April 13 Tuesday</b>	<b>Birdoswald – Roman Army Museum – Peebles.</b> We depart early and head south across the border country on a scenic two-hour drive to Birdoswald Roman Fort — one of the best-preserved stretches of Hadrian's Wall. Walk the ancient ramparts and imagine life on the very edge of the Roman Empire nearly 2,000 years ago. After a lunch break, we visit the outstanding Roman Army Museum, a brilliantly designed and immersive attraction featuring life-size reconstructions, dramatic film experiences, and remarkable artefacts that bring the Roman frontier vividly to life. It's a fascinating and energetic day before we head back north to Peebles for one final evening in the Scottish Borders. Dinner & Overnight: Peebles Hydro Hotel.
<b>DAY 5</b>	<b>April 14 Wednesday</b>	<b>Duncarron Medieval Village – The Kelpies – Grangemouth.</b> We depart and head north toward the Forth Valley. Duncarron Medieval Village is a remarkable achievement — a fully authentic early medieval Scottish fortified settlement, hand-built by the Clanranald Trust for Scotland using traditional methods and materials. It's a truly unique and immersive experience. In the afternoon we visit The Kelpies, the awe-inspiring 30-metre-high steel horse-head sculptures by artist Andy Scott, now one of Scotland's most iconic landmarks. Standing at the eastern entrance to the Forth & Clyde Canal, they are extraordinary up close. We then settle in to our hotel near Grangemouth for the night. Dinner & Overnight: Macdonald Inchyra Hotel, Grangemouth.
<b>DAY 6</b>	<b>April 15 Thursday</b>	<b>Rosebank Distillery – Return to Edinburgh.</b> Our final day visits the award-winning Rosebank Distillery (rosebank.com) in Falkirk — a superb single malt with a guided tour and tasting. We then return to Edinburgh for a free afternoon: stroll the Royal Mile, visit the Castle, or enjoy a farewell dinner on your own. Overnight: Ibis Edinburgh Centre Royal Mile.
<b>DAY 7</b>	<b>April 16 Friday</b>	<b>Edinburgh – Airport Transfer.</b> After breakfast, your group transfer departs for Edinburgh Airport, bringing your Scottish adventure to a close. Safe travels, and we hope to see you on the road again soon!
