Sept. 16	pub in Ireland, and maybe even the world. The modest pub's history dates back more than one thousand years. It is now on to Westport! This			
Saturday	bright and vibrant town is a photogenic Georgian town with tree-lined streets, and a great vibe. With fine restaurants and pubs renowned for			
	their music, it's a hugely popular place yet has never sold its soul to tourism. Few towns in Ireland can match Westport's charm and continental			
	flavor. Cheerful and multi-colored shop fronts jostle for attention with an attractive selection of shops, pubs, cafés and restaurants. Little			
	wonder it has become one of Ireland's most popular and cosmopolitan holiday destinations. Dinner & Overnight at the Castlecourt Hotel			
	Westport.			
Day 3	Westport. After enjoying breakfast, we meet our driver guide in the lobby of the hotel and begin to tour The Connemara National Park.			
Sept. 17	Connemara (Conmaicnemara – the tribe of Cormac by the sea), white sand beaches, dark bogs and tall jagged mountains make this one of the

	to Clifden (An Clochan). Founded in the early 19th century by John D'Arcy, it retains much of its Georgian architecture. Placed at the head of			
	a broad Atlantic Bay and nestled below the Twelve Bens, the town is blessed by its beautiful setting. Known as the capital of Connemara,			
D - 4	Clifden is a lively location full of shops, pubs, restaurants and cafés. Overnight at the Castlecourt Hotel Westport.			
Day 4	Westport- Killarney. This morning after breakfast we leave Westport and travel to the Cliffs of Moher. The cliffs are astonishingly impressive			
Sept. 18	and staggeringly beautiful. The entirely vertical cliffs rise to a height of 203m, their edge falling away abruptly into a ceaselessly churning			
Monday	Atlantic. A progression of vast heads, the dark limestone marches in a rigid formation that's gob-smacking, no matter how many times you look at it. On a clear day you'll channel Barbra Streisand as you can see forever; the Aran Islands stand etched on the waters of Galway Bay, and			
	beyond lie the hills of Connemara. Then we make our way to Killarney. Dinner & Overnight at the Killarney Plaza Hotel.			
Day 5	Killarney. Today after breakfast weather permitting, we visit Skellig Michael. The jagged, 217m-high rock of Skellig Michael (Michael's			
Sept. 19	Rock; like St Michael's Mount in Cornwall and Mont St Michael in Normandy) is the larger of the two Skellig Islands and a Unesco World			
Tuesday	Heritage site. Early Christian monks established a community and survived here from the 6th until the 12th or 13th century. The monastic			
Tuesday	buildings perch on a saddle in the rock, some 150m above sea level, reached by 618 steep steps cut into the rock face. Skellig Michael was			
	famously featured as Luke Skywalker's Jedi temple in Star Wars: The Force Awakens (2015) and Star Wars: The Last Jedi (2017), attracting a			
	whole new audience to the island's dramatic beauty. Overnight at the Killarney Plaza Hotel.			
Day 6	Killarney- Dublin. Today after breakfast we leave Killarney and make our way to Dublin. Our first stop is at the Rock of Cashel. The Rock of			
Sept. 20	Cashel is one of Ireland's most spectacular historic sites: a prominent green hill, banded with limestone outcrops, rising from a grassy plain and			

Wednesday	bristling with ancient fortifications. Sturdy walls circle an enclosure containing a round tower, a 13th-century Gothic cathedral and the finest			
	12th-century Romanesque chapel in Ireland, home to some of the land's oldest frescoes. It's a five-minute stroll from the town centre up to the			
	the Rock, from where fantastic views range over the Tipperary countryside. After our visit, we continue to our destination Dublin. Overnight			
	at the Camden Court Hotel.			
Day 7	Dublin. Today time to explore Dublin. We start with a visit to Trinity College, the College is Ireland's most prestigious university, a collection			
Sept. 21	of elegant Georgian and Victorian buildings, cobbled squares and nature-friendly wildflower meadows that make for a delightful place to			
Thursday	wander. The Old Library, one of the most photographed rooms in Dublin, and the Book of Kells, the beautifully illuminated Gospel manuscript

Sept. 22	burial site read like a 'who's who' of Irish history, as most of the leading names of the past 150 years are buried here, including Daniel			
Friday	O'Connell and Charles Stewart Parnell. It was established in 1832 by O'Connell as a burial ground for people of all faiths – a high-minded			
	response to Protestant cemeteries' refusal to bury Catholics. Covering 124 acres, the original Victorian garden cemetery has grown to			
	encompass new lawn-style plots and memorial gardens, all nestled in amongst mature trees and the beautiful monuments to Ireland's past for			
	which Glasnevin is famous for. This afternoon you will have time to explore Dublin. Overnight at the Camden Court Hotel.			
Day 9	Dublin Airport- US. Today we make our way to Dublin Airport for our flight home. (One Group Transfer)
