Tuesday	the 12th century, though much of its present look dates from Victorian times. Go back in time and explore Ireland's Medieval Mile, a		
	discovery trail running through Kilkenny city. The county is full of vibrant heritage and history at every turn, so there are many storie		
	for you to uncover in Kilkenny. Overnight at The Kilkenny Rivercourt Hotel.		
Day 4	Kilkenny- Killarney. After breakfast we continue on to Killarney. After a full Irish breakfast we make our way to Blarney Castle,

	particularly wide range of cut crystal, porcelain presents and its trademark woolly things. The Killarney International.
