Rocking the Country (of Ireland) Tour

Day 1 November 10 Sunday	Dublin Airport- Killarney. Morning arrival at Dublin Airport (Please arrive by 10:00AM) where after clearing customs and collecting your luggage, you will meet your driver guide in the arrival hall of Dublin Airport. He will check you in for the tour and take the group to your awaiting coach. We begin our journey by making our way southwest to Killarney. Upon arrival to Killarney, we check into our hotel for the evening, The Killarney International Hotel. Tonight, we have a welcome dinner scheduled for the group at the hotel. Day 2 November 11 Monday	Killarney. Today we enjoy Killarney and its surrounding beauty. We will enjoy a jaunting cart horse and carriage ride through Killarney National Park. Explore the beauty of Lake Killarney and the Killarney National Park. The Park is one of the gems of the town, set against the backdrop of the three lakes of Killarney. You take in the beauty it offers firsthand, and maybe even come face to face with some of the local wildlife, including the red deer. For those looking to golf, perhaps you book a tee time at Killarney Golf & Fishing Club which is only about a 10-minute ride from the hotel. Overnight Killarney International Hotel.
Day 3 November 12 Tuesday	Ring of Kerry. We then start on a full day tour of “The Ring.” There is an unspoiled nature to Ireland's most beautiful region and the <i>Ring of Kerry</i> provides many unforgettable memories as it passes through the many picturesque villages such as Glenbeigh, Waterville and Sneem and returns via Ladies View and the famous Lakes of Killarney. For those looking for a free day, you certainly have the option to stay behind and explore town. Tonight, Lefty Lucy will put on a show at the hotel! Overnight Killarney International Hotel.
Day 4 November 13 Wednesday	Killarney- Cork. Today we meet our guide in the lobby of the hotel. Our next stop, Blarney Castle , is home to the Blarney Stone. Here you can plant your lips on the Blarney Stone , which supposedly gives one the gift of gab. The Blarney Stone is perched at the top of a steep climb up a spiral staircase. On the battlements, you bend backwards over a long, long drop (with safety grill and attendant to prevent tragedy) to kiss the stone; Time to visit and shop the famous woolen mills. We continue to Cork. Overnight Imperial Hotel Cork.
Day 5 November 14 Thursday	Cork. Today we enjoy a panoramic tour of Cork City, home to several magnificent churches including St. Ann’s and St. Finbar’s cathedral. Cork City is the second largest city in Ireland and takes its name from the Irish word Corcaigh meaning “marshy place.” Perhaps you visit the English Market. The current mix of traders in the English Market represents diversity as broad as at any time over the centuries of its existence. Small stalls sit alongside larger businesses. Fledgling traders

	beside long-established family businesses passed down from one generation to the next. Meats and fish, herbs and spices, fruit and vegetables, sauces and oils, chocolates and cakes, cheeses, and pastas – the Market caters for all culinary tastes and all eating occasions!! For those looking to venture on their own, perhaps book a tee time at Fota Island Golf about 20 minutes from the hotel. Tonight, Lefty Lucy will put on a show at the hotel! Overnight Imperial Hotel Cork.
Day 6 November 15 Friday	Cork- Dublin. Today we meet our guide in the lobby of the hotel and we leave Cork and make our way to Dublin. Our first stop is at the Rock of Cashel. The Rock of Cashel is one of Ireland's most spectacular historic sites: a prominent green hill, banded with limestone outcrops, rising from a grassy plain and bristling with ancient fortifications. Sturdy walls circle an enclosure containing a round tower, a 13th-century Gothic cathedral and the finest 12th-century Romanesque chapel in Ireland, home to some of the land's oldest frescoes. It's a five-minute stroll from the town centre up to the the Rock, from where fantastic views range over the Tipperary countryside. After our visit, we continue to our destination Dublin. Dinner & Overnight at the Camden Court Hotel.
Day 7 November 16 Saturday	Dublin. Today time to explore Dublin. Enjoy Dublin Sightseeing at your own pace with the ever-popular City Sightseeing Hop-On Hop-Off Dublin Bus Tour. For reference: https://city-sightseeing.com/en/50/dublin/60/hop-on-hop-off-dublin The strategic route and stops cover all the major Dublin attractions. You have unlimited hop-on, hop-off access and with frequent departures, your valuable Dublin sightseeing time will not be wasted waiting for the next bus. Hop on and off at the well-placed stops to see attractions of your choice. You could also sit back and simply enjoy a drive around the charming city. Day 8 November 17 Sunday	Dublin Airport- US. Today we make our way to Dublin Airport for our flight home. (One Group Transfer)
