Day 6	Killarney- Galway. This morning after breakfast we leave Killarney and travel firstly to Listowel where we will visit the			
October 26	Playwrite and author John B Keane's pub. Here we will have some song and stories from local entertainers. A complementary			
Saturday	drink while we listen to them tell some true stories and not so true stories!!! We will head out of Listowel and on for the Cliffs of			
	Moher. The cliffs are astonishingly impressive and staggeringly beautiful. The entirely vertical cliffs rise to a height of 700 feet,			
	their edge falling away abruptly into a ceaselessly churning Atlantic. A progression of vast heads, the dark limestone marches in			
	a rigid formation that's gob-smacking, no matter how many times you look at it. On a clear day you'll channel Barbra Streisand as			
	you can see forever; the Aran Islands stand etched on the waters of Galway Bay, and beyond lie the hills of Connemara. Then			
	onto Galway. Enjoy some free time this afternoon Overnight at the Galmont Hotel Galway.			
Day 7	Galway. After enjoying breakfast we meet our driver guide in the lobby of the hotel and begin to tour The Connemara National			
October 27	Park. Connemara, white sand beaches, dark bogs and tall jagged mountains make this one of the most scenic and unspoiled areas			
Sunday	in the country. Wild and rugged, in some places here, Gaelic remains the only spoken language. We travel first to Clifden.			
	Founded in the early 19th century by John D'Arcy, it retains much of its Georgian architecture. Placed at the head of a broad			
	Atlantic Bay and nestled below the Twelve Bens, the town is blessed by its beautiful setting We will also make a stop at the			
	Connemara Marble factory for touring and shopping. There will also be a very special surprise on this day. You won't want to			
	miss it. Overnight at the Galmont Hotel Galway.			
Day 8	Galway- Dublin. After breakfast we head to Dublin. We travel into Dublin Town where we enjoy a panoramic tour of this 1000-			
October 28	year-old city. We then see statue filled O'Connell Street, The General Post Office scene of the 1916 Easter Uprising, as well as
