Day 1, November 13 – Saturday: Dublin Airport – Athlone – Galway. Welcome to Ireland! After landing at Dublin Airport, your Hammond Tours Irish Driver Guide will meet you and the group departs by 10:00 AM. Our first stop is the legendary **Sean's Bar** in Athlone — one of the oldest pubs in the world — for a whiskey tasting. We then continue west to **Galway**, one of Ireland's most vibrant cities, perched on the edge of the Wild Atlantic Way. Check in and settle in for the evening. **Overnight: Imperial Hotel, Galway.**

Day 2, November 14 – Sunday: Connemara – Kylemore Abbey. After breakfast, we head into the wild beauty of **Connemara** — a landscape of mountains, bogs, and glittering lakes. We visit the magnificent **Kylemore Abbey**, a stunning neo-Gothic castle set against a mirror lake, and enjoy a **Joyce's Sheepdog** demonstration — an entertaining display of Border Collies herding a flock with nothing but whistles and hand signals. Return to Galway for the evening. **Overnight: Imperial Hotel, Galway.**

Day 3, November 15 – Monday: Cliffs of Moher – Killarney. We depart Galway and travel south to one of Ireland's most iconic natural wonders: the **Cliffs of Moher**. Rising over 700 feet above the Atlantic, the views on a clear day stretch all the way to the Aran Islands. We continue south to the beautiful town of **Killarney**, nestled among lakes and mountains. **Dinner & Overnight: International Hotel, Killarney.**

Day 4, November 16 – Tuesday: Dingle Peninsula. A spectacular day on one of the most beautiful drives in all of Europe. We take a **Jaunting Car** ride through **Killarney National Park** before heading out along **Slea Head Drive** — a loop of the Dingle Peninsula with ancient beehive huts, dramatic headlands, and wild Atlantic views. **Overnight: International Hotel, Killarney.**

Day 5, November 17 – Wednesday: Blarney Castle – Cork. We travel to the legendary **Blarney Castle**, where you can kiss the famous Blarney Stone and explore the castle's beautiful gardens. We then continue to **Cork**, Ireland's vibrant second city, built along the channels of the River Lee. **Dinner & Overnight: Imperial Hotel, Cork.**

Day 6, November 18 – Thursday: Kilkenny – Guinness Storehouse – Dublin. We travel northeast, stopping at the magnificent **Kilkenny Castle** — a stunning Norman fortress at the heart of Ireland's medieval capital. We continue to **Dublin**, arriving in time to visit the world-famous **Guinness Storehouse** before settling in for the evening. **Overnight: Camden Court Hotel, Dublin.**

Day 7, November 19 – Friday: Free Day in Dublin. A free day to discover Dublin at your own pace. Your included **24-Hour Hop On Hop Off Bus Pass** is the perfect way to take in the city's great landmarks — Trinity College, Temple Bar, St. Patrick's Cathedral, and the Georgian squares. **Overnight: Camden Court Hotel, Dublin.**

Day 8, November 20 – Saturday: Dublin – Depart. After breakfast, our group transfer departs from the Camden Court Hotel to Dublin Airport for your homeward flight. Safe travels — and thank you for sharing this journey through Ireland with CrossBow and Hammond Tours. Until next time!
