# **Rambling House West of Ireland Tour April** 9<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> 2026

Day 1	<b>Dublin-Kiltimagh.</b> Arrive in Dublin where, after clearing customs, we are met by our professional Irish Driver-Guide. The tour
April 9	will begin in the afternoon, allowing for transatlantic arrivals earlier in the day. Depart Dublin Airport and travel west passing
Thursday	through the heart of Ireland's Midlands. The route brings you to well-known towns such as Enfield and Athlone, where the road
	skirts the River Shannon, before continuing into the quieter roads of the west. As you cross into County Mayo, the scenery
	shifts to open farmland, turf bogs, and small villages, offering a clear sense of rural Ireland. Arrive in the town of Kiltimagh and
	check in at the centrally located Kiltimagh Park Hotel, a comfortable base for exploring the region. Dinner & Overnight

Day 2	Kiltimagh. After breakfast, enjoy a morning session of music, poetry, and storytelling at the Folk Café, a wonderful

	cultural space showcasing visual art and community creativity—both located just a short walk from the café. <b>Overnight</b>

Day 3	Kiltimagh – Museum of Country Life – Foxford – Kiltimagh. Depart Kiltimagh this morning and travel to the National
April 11	Museum of Ireland – Country Life, set in the scenic grounds of Turlough Park, where engaging exhibitions bring Ireland's rural
Saturday	traditions, customs, and daily life of the past into sharp focus. Continue on to Foxford to visit the renowned Foxford Woollen
	Mills, a beautifully restored 19th-century mill showcasing Ireland's textile heritage, with time to browse the shop or enjoy lunch
	by the River Moy. Return to Kiltimagh in the afternoon for a relaxed evening and overnight. Overnight Kiltimagh Park
	Hotel
Day 4	Kiltimagh- Connemara- Connemara Coast Hotel. Depart Kiltimagh this morning and journey south and west into the heart
April 12	of Connemara, one of Ireland's most rugged and dramatic regions. Travel through changing landscapes of open bogland, stone
Sunday	walls, and mountain scenery, passing through coastal villages and open Connemara countryside. Travel through the town of

	and sweeping coastal vistas—before arriving at the seaside Connemara Coast Hotel, overlooking Galway Bay. Check in and
	enjoy the coastal setting as you settle in for the evening. Dinner and Overnight Connemara Coast Hotel.
Day 5	Free Day in Galway. Late this morning, travel into Galway for a relaxed free afternoon in one of Ireland's most lively and
April 13	atmospheric cities. Enjoy time to explore the Latin Quarter, browse the shops along Shop Street, or settle into a pub or café and
Monday	soak up Galway's unmistakable energy. An optional guided walking tour of Galway with Brian Nolan will be available for those
	who wish to explore the city's history, stories, and hidden corners with a local expert. (Booked on own directly) From 4:00–6:00
	PM, regroup at The Quays Bar for a band session, a quintessential Galway experience where music, conversation, and local
	character come together. After the session, return to the coast for the evening, having enjoyed both the city's freedom and its
	famous live music scene. Overnight Connemara Coast Hotel.

Day 6	Connemara Coast Hotel- Spiddal Craft Village- Coral Strand. Depart the Connemara Coast Hotel this morning and travel
April 14	west along the coast to Spiddal Craft Village, where local workshops and studios showcase Connemara's strong tradition of
Tuesday	pottery, weaving, jewelry, and visual arts. Continue on to the nearby Coral Strand, a unique pale-sand beach created from
	crushed coral, offering beautiful coastal views and a true sense of the wild Atlantic landscape. After time to enjoy the scenery
	and fresh sea air, return to the Connemara Coast Hotel for a relaxed afternoon and evening. <b>Overnight Connemara Coast</b>
	Hotel.
Day 7	Connemara – Ballaghaderreen. Depart the Connemara Coast Hotel this morning and travel north into County Mayo, arriving
April 15	in Ballaghaderreen. This afternoon, enjoy a walk into town to Mulligan's Hardware & Pub, a wonderfully traditional local
Wednesday	gathering place where shelves of tools and farm supplies sit side by side with the bar—an authentic slice of west-of-Ireland life.
	Return on foot and settle in for a relaxed evening at Durkin's Guesthouse, a welcoming, family-run property. <b>Overnight</b>

Day 8	Ballagh- Monastraden- Terry's House. Depart Durkin's Guesthouse this morning and travel east into County Sligo for a
April 16	deeply personal and culturally rich day. Begin with a visit to the Holy Well at Monastraden, a quiet and atmospheric site rooted
Thursday	in local spiritual tradition. Continue on to Casey Cashleen, a meaningful stop connected to local heritage and storytelling. A
	special highlight of the day is a private visit to Terry Casey's family home, offering a rare and intimate connection to personal
	history and place. Afterward, return to Ballagh for a relaxed evening and overnight once again at Durkin's Guesthouse.

Day 9	Ballagh- Arigna Mines- Dublin. Depart Ballagh this morning and travel east to the Arigna Mining Experience, where guided
April 17	tours led by former miners bring Ireland's coal-mining history vividly to life deep underground. After time to explore the
Friday	exhibits and enjoy lunch in the café, continue onward through the Midlands toward Dublin. Arrive in Dublin later in the day,
